- Please remove tags from previous garage sales. It takes our volunteers extra time to remove tags to price for our sale.
- Use zip top bags to keep pieces/parts together for games, puzzles, seasonal decor, craft kits, jewelry, etc.


## We cannot accept:

- large appliances
- hard wired lighting/fans
- televisions/monitors
- VCR/DVD players
- speakers, answering machines or other electronics accessories
- cribs
- car seats or boosters
- mattresses
- wheelchairs, walkers or other medical equipment
- broken items or items with missing pieces
- out of date/damaged/incomplete sports equipment
