## The Prayer Prompt



Sources tell us that we need to hear a message 2-7 times before the message begins to sink in so that we understand. I am not certain how accurate this is but when I think about it in terms of how Jesus taught his disciples I think Jesus understood this. In Matthew 13, Jesus once again tells the crowds about the seeds growing in different soils. Once again, the disciples ask Jesus why he is teaching in parables. It is as if Jesus needs to keep giving the same message to the disciples so that it will eventually sink in and stick! We are the same way. Sometimes, we hear a story from scripture or read a verse we've long had memorized and all of the sudden it takes on a different or deeper meaning. This week, as you engage with God's world and word, pray that your heart would be good soil. Don't assume it. Pray for it and see what fruit you might bear.
