The Spiritual Practice of Sacred Listening

1. Find a quiet place where you won't be disturbed.
2. Read Luke 10:38-42 slowly and deliberately, not with an intellectual or utilitarian perspective but in a relational and transformational way.
3. Allow the Holy Spirit to guide your heart and mind to become aware of the presence of God.
4. As you read, notice where the text seems to draw you in or speaks to you. Is there a correction or invitation to you?
5. Thank God for the opportunity to spend time in the best way possible, learning from Jesus.
