Pastors Jon Larson & Amelia Houdek would love to connect with you, say hello.

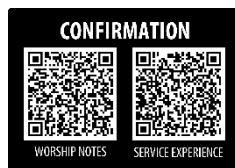
Listening devices are available at the Welcome Desk.

Summer Adventures

All camps are full for this summer, registrations for next summer will open late January early February 2026

Even though we don't have formal education in the summer months, our students stay busy!

- We started the summer with 206 kids (age 4-4th grade) at Vacation Bible School.
- This past week we had 102 girls (1st-5th grade) at our American Girl camp.
- Today we have 11 kids (1st-3rd grade) returning from Camp Wapo "Seeds Camp", and 64 kids (4th-8th grade) heading to Camp Wapo's "Youth Camp" for the week.
- Next week we have 24 students (8th-12th grade) and 4 adults going on a Montana Adventure trip.
- The first week of August we have 35 students (5th-8th grade) at "Serve Camp", serving at King of Kings and throughout the metro.

A Special Thank You from King's Sisters · Thank you to all that contributed kitchen tools and the 22 King's Sisters who constructed the kits. We made 102 completed kitchen packs for Bridging and provided additional components to help them make more kitchen packs. Bridging is a nonprofit that provides donated furniture and household goods for those transitioning to housing stability. Bridging has served nearly 115,000 households and more than 345,000 individuals throughout the metro area.
