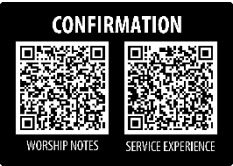


Welcome! We're Glad You're Here!

Music & Worship

Music in worship is more than sound; it's a spiritual language that reaches where words cannot. It refreshes weary souls, unites generations and gives voice to the deepest expressions of faith, joy and longing.

Whether in traditional hymns or modern praise songs, music draws us into the presence of God, reminds us of His truth and invites us to respond with our whole hearts. As Scripture calls us, "Make a joyful noise to the Lord, all the earth. Worship the Lord with gladness; come into his presence with singing." When we lead or participate in worship through music, we lift our voices and offer our gifts as one body glorifying God, engaging both heart and mind in devotion and guiding others to encounter God in community.
